

## HOW TO FIND US...

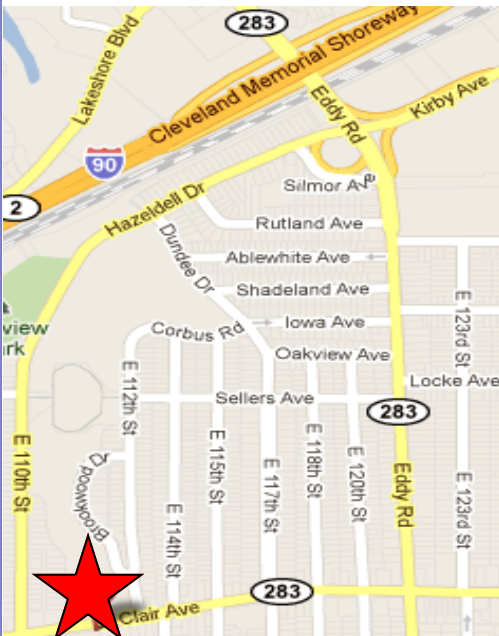
**From the East via I-90:** Take I-90 West. Take Exit 178 toward Bratenahl. Turn left on Eddy Road. Turn right on St. Clair

**From the West via I-90:** Take I-90 East/OH-2 East toward Cleveland. Take exit 170B to continue on I-90 East toward Cleveland. Take Exit 178 for Eddy Road toward Bratenahl. Turn right on Eddy Road. Turn Right at St. Clair

**From the South via I-77:** Take I-77 North toward Cleveland. Take Exit 163 on the left and merge onto I-90 East, toward East 9th Street. Follow signs for I-90 East/Eric, PA and merge onto I-90 East. Take Exit 178 for Eddy Road toward Bratenahl. Turn right at Eddy Road. Turn left onto St. Clair Avenue.

**From the South via I-271**

Take I-271 North. Exit I-90 West toward Cleveland. Take Exit 178 for Eddy Road toward Bratenahl. Turn left onto Eddy Road. Turn right onto St. Clair Avenue.

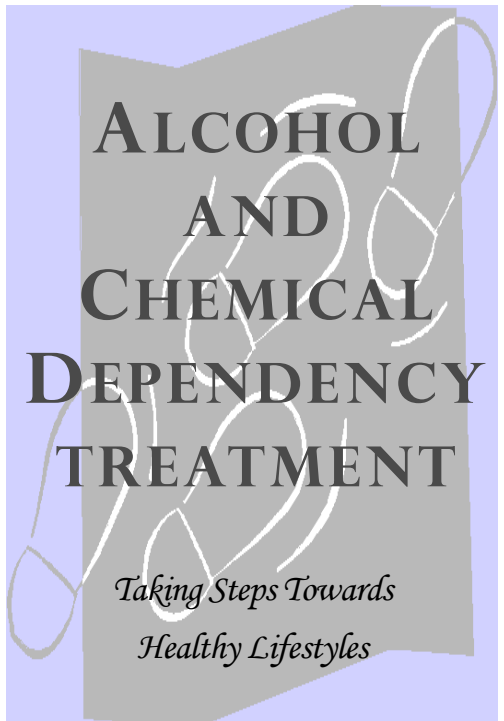

## Intake/Assessment

- 24-72 hour response time
- Substance abuse assessment
- Treatment referral to appropriate level of care
- Pregnant women receive preferential admission
- Detox customers will receive an intake appointment within 24 hours from time of referral.

## Case Management

- Housing referral
- Employment referral
- Education referral
- Community based support

## Intensive Outpatient (IOP) Treatment

- Group treatment
- Program duration: approximately 90 days
- 3 sessions per week
- 3 hours per session
- Individual counseling
- Urine screens

Group Days: M, W, F  
Group Times: 9:00 a.m.-12 p.m.



## Outpatient (OP) Treatment

- Group treatment
- Program duration: approximately 60 days
- 2 sessions per week
- 2 hours per session
- Individual counseling
- Urine screens

Group Days: T, TH  
Group Times: 9:30 a.m.-11:30 a.m.
