



The Respiratory Report summarizes influenza, COVID-19, and Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) activity in the City of Cleveland during each week of respiratory illness season. Respiratory illness season starts at the beginning of October (MMWR week 40\*) and lasts until mid-May the following year (MMWR week 20).

## Week 45 Summary

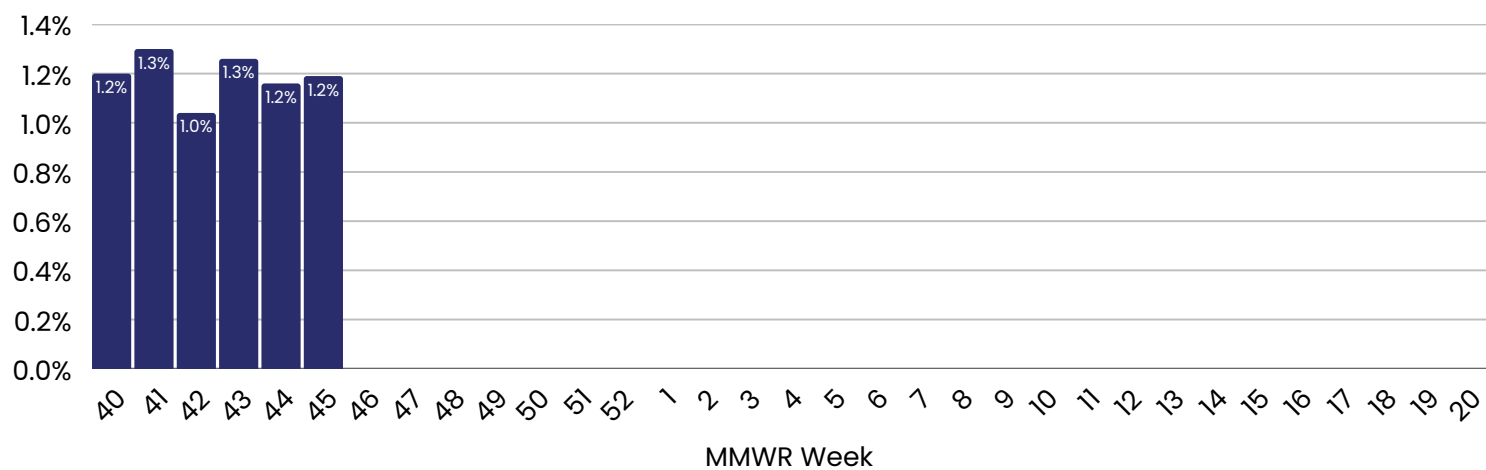
- 1.2% of emergency department (ED) visits were for influenza-like illnesses (ILI) with fevers.
- There were 3 hospitalizations for COVID and 2 hospitalizations for Influenza reported this week. Hospitalization and death data often experience a delay in reporting, so more data for this week may appear on future reports.
