

### **Current Year (2017):**

- 3808 newly diagnosed cases of Gonorrhea in Cleveland, OH
- The number of new cases increased by 32% compared to 2016
- 55% of new cases in Cleveland are among persons younger than 25 years of age

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### Previous Year (2016):

- 2878 newly diagnosed cases of Gonorrhea in Cleveland, OH
- The number of new cases increased by 24% compared to 2015


